GENERAL RULES & GUIDELINES

- The Machine Mania event will consist of 10 events: Motorcycle Racing, Classic Car Show, Truck & Tractor Pulls, Equipment Competition, Lawn Mower Racing, Framers 500 Trash Car Race, and a Demolition Derby
- Entries are on a first come, first served basis. There may be a limit on the number of teams competing in the events. This is at the discretion of the event coordinator and is subject to time constraints and resources. Entries will receive a confirmation of participation notification once the entry form is received and any entry fee has been paid.
- Strict adherence to safety is a must and any contestant that engages in dangerous operation of equipment, horseplay, abusive or distracting language during an event can and will result in disqualification from the competition and all points forfeited. Each judge overseeing the events will have a whistle (or horn) that will be used to control the events and maintain safety. All contestants who hear the judges' whistle will be required to immediately stop the operation of equipment and await instruction from the judge.
- Machine Mania events at the Oregon State Fair carry risk to participants. All participants will be required to sign a waiver stating they understand and acknowledge the risks to personal injury involved. All participants will agree to hold GK Machine, Inc., its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or any other official of the event, harmless from all liability from participating in the events.
- All participants must be in good physical condition, capable of participating without risk to self or others. All participants must be 18 years of age and able to show proof of age.
- Decisions of judges for each event are final.
- The Equipment Competitions will consist of four events and a Grand Championship based on accumulative total of points earn in each of the four events. An individual may enter all four events and earn points towards the Championship. Individuals not entered in all four categories are not eligible for the Championship.
- Equipment Championships will be determined by overall total points from all four competitions. In case of a tie; will be based on the number of 1st and 2nd place wins in each of the four competitions.
